

ATTENTION ALL PERSONS ENTERING THE FACILITY

FOR THE SAFETY OF OUR PATIENTS, RESIDENTS, STAFF and VISITORS:

Everyone entering the facility must adhere to the following core infection prevention practices:



Perform hand hygiene at entrance to the facility **AND** <u>before</u> and <u>after</u> any contact with the patient/resident.

You can use soap and water OR an alcohol-based hand rub





Cover your <u>mouth and nose</u> with a tissue when you cough or sneezeput used tissue in the waste basket **OR** cough or sneeze into your upper sleeve, not your hands. Clean your hands after coughing or sneezing.

You may also be required to wear source control <u>based on county</u> transmission AND/OR facility policy.

WHAT TO DO IF?



IF YOU CURRENTLY HAVE A COVID-19 INFECTION?

Do not visit <u>in-person</u> until you have gone at least 10 days since your first symptom or first positive test, had no fever for 24 hours and if you had symptoms they have resolved.

IF YOU CURRENTLY HAVE SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19 INFECTION?

Do not visit <u>in-person</u> until you have tested and are negative for COVID-19. If negative and still have respiratory symptoms, wear a face mask while in the facility.



IF YOU HAVE BEEN EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WITH COVID-19 WITHIN THE PAST 10 DAYS, BUT HAVE NO SYMPTOMS?

Wear a face mask while you are in the facility. If you cannot wear a face mask or choose not to wear a face mask do not visit in person until 10 days have passed since your exposure. You should be tested at 24 hours after your exposure and if negative, test again in 48 hours and if negative test again at 48 hours after last negative test.

These instructions are in accordance with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Recommendations (CDC)
